History

Southminster Presbyterian Church

Southminster Presbyterian Church, located in the South Mountain Village of Phoenix, AZ is the only African-American congregation in the Synod of the Southwest and the Grand Canyon Presbytery.

Dr. George Benjamin Brooks was the founding and first pastor. The church was established March 23, 1954 with a long history of being the focal point in the community, directing efforts geared towards improving the quality of life for its members and community residents.

In fulfilling its mission, Southminster has responded to the need for pre-school education and the need for food and nutrition programs for children and the aging. The Southminster Head Start Program received the first national award granted more than 47 years ago.

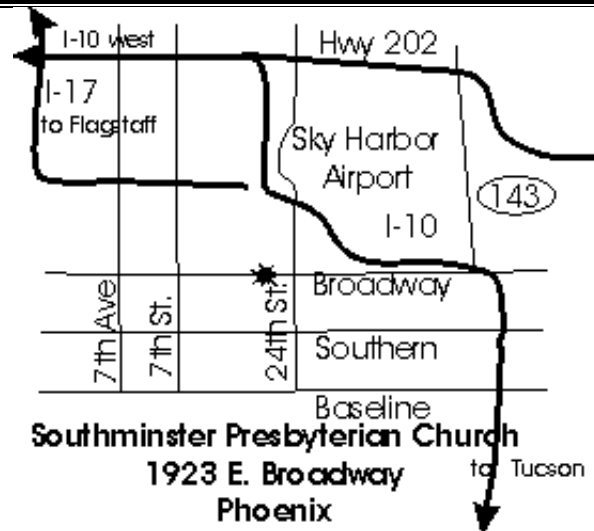
There are three ways to become a member of the Church:

Driving Directions



From the North

I - 17 (North Black Canyon Freeway) Exit 195A, Take Ramp (Right) onto E. Maricopa Freeway. Turn Right (South) onto South 16th Street, Turn Left (East) onto E. Broadway Road. Arrive at 1923 E. Broadway Road.

From the South East

AZ-101 Loop: Exit 55, Turn Right onto Ramp towards US-60/Phoenix/Globe. Keep left to stay on Ramp towards US-60/Phoenix. Take Ramp (Left) onto US-

60 (Superstition Freeway). Take Ramp (Right) onto I - 10 (US - 60) towards I-10/US-60/Phoenix. At Exit 152, Turn Right onto Ramp towards 40th Street, Turn Right (West) onto E. Broadway Road. Arrive at 1923 E. Broadway Road.

From the East

I-10/US 60/Phoenix Exit 152, Turn Right onto Ramp towards 40th Street. Turn Left (South) onto South 40th Street. Turn Right (West) onto E. Broadway Road, Arrive at 1923 E. Broadway Road.

From the West

US-60 (W. Grand Avenue) to West Thomas Road, Turn Right (South) onto N. Black Canyon Highway) towards I-17. At Exit 195A, Take Ramp (Right) onto E. Maricopa Freeway. Turn Right (South) onto S. 16th Street, Turn Left (East) onto E. Broadway Road, Arrive at 1923 E. Broadway Road.
